SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., wherein the petitioners seek the indulgence of anticipatory bail.

2. In FIR bearing No.77 of 05.04.2022, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana, offences constituted under Sections 364, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, are embodied.

3. Since in respect of co-accused Kamaljit Singh @ Babban and others, this court on 01.06.2022, upon CRM-M-24755-2022, had ordered for their becoming admitted to anticipatory bail, therefore, when the role of the present bail petitioners is not more heinous, or, more grievous than the one, as attributed to the bail petitioners (supra),

thereupon, on the principle of parity, the present bail petitioner, becomes amenable for being treated similarly, with the bail petitioners in the petition (supra).

4. Given the above, and also, when the learned State Counsel also submits, that during the course of the investigating officer concerned conducting, the investigations into the petition FIR, the bail petitioners have rendered their fullest co-operation to him, and, besides when no evidence is adduced before this Court by the prosecution, suggestive of the fact, that in the event of the petitioners, becoming admitted to anticipatory bail, there is every likelihood of theirs fleeing from justice, and, tampering with the prosecution evidence, therefore this Court becomes constrained to admit the present petitioners to anticipatory bail.

5. In nutshell, the instant petition is allowed, and, the order made by this Court on 10.05.2022, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

6. The afore observations are meant only for the disposal of the present petition, and, shall not affect the merits of the trial arising from the FIR (supra).
