Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present revision has been filed against the order dated 23.03.2021 passed by Fast Track Court under POCSO Act vide which the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 10.03.2021 passed by Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board-cum-Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala declining him bail on the ground that his release will expose him to moral, physical and psychological danger and will defeat the ends of justice was dismissed.

The petitioner was involved in a case FIR No.28 dated 21.01.2021, under Section 6 of POCSO Act and Section 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Naraingarh.

At the outset, learned State counsel has pointed out that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and the trial is at the fag end and is likely to be concluded shortly.

In view of the above, I do not find any justification in ordering release of the petitioner on bail in the present case. Revision petition is, accordingly, dismissed. However, the trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the earliest.
