[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings against the respondents for fraudulent withdrawals of money from the account of his mentally ill father Shri Harbans Singh, despite having no legal authority for the same.

[2] In view of the statement of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
