Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 & 2 to remove the pay anomaly between senior and junior employees. Further prayer is for directing respondent No.1 to decide representation(s) dated 15.07.2020 (P-7) and pay anomaly cases dated 27.10.2020/31.10.2020 (P-8).

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioners submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the aforesaid representation(s) dated 15.07.2020 (P-7) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 & 2 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioners, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1-Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid representation(s) dated 15.07.2020 (P-7) by passing speaking order as per law within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
