Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in permissive possession of the land in dispute for more than 50 years. A public notice has been pasted in the locality that all occupants would have to vacate their respective premises on or before 22.04.2022. Against the said notice, representation dated 25.04.2022 was submitted whereafter another 15 days have been granted. Nobody can be evicted from land which is in permissive possession without following the due process of law and without rehabilitating them.

Mr. Arun Gosain, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending representation dated 25.04.2022 (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order within twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Till then, the petitioner will not be dispossessed.
