Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that all the benefits, for the which the petitioner was entitled for, have already been extended to her but as there is a delay in releasing the same, the petitioner may kindly be given a liberty to approach the respondents to seek interest on the said delayed payments keeping in view the judgment passed by the Full Bench of this Court in “**A.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab and others**”, 1997(3) SCT 468.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner seeking the grant of interest on the said delayed payments, the same will be considered and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation and in case after the said decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any interest on the said delayed payments, the same will be released in her favour within a period of next four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view

the statements made by learned State counsel, recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioner remains in the present petition at this stage, and therefore, he may kindly be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation seeking the grant of interest on the said delayed payments.

Ordered accordingly.
