Prayer is for grant for regular bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.892 dated 30.12.2021 registered under Sections 411, 201, 420, 467, 468, 471, 482 and 483 read with Section 34 of IPC, Police Station Samalkha, Panipat, Haryana.

Notice.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Naveen K. Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the police received complaint that the petitioner, Mohit, Vikas and Tushar @ Kala were involved in theft of vehicles and used to dismantle them in workshop

of Tushar @ Kala situated in the area of Samalkha and then used to sell the spare parts of stolen vehicles. Accordingly, the police raided aforesaid workshop from where the petitioner and Mohit were apprehended along with one stolen car bearing fake number plate, on 30.12.2021. The petitioner was arrested at the spot.

As has been admitted by the State counsel, the petitioner is in custody for 30.12.2021. The recoveries have already been effected in the present case. As per the State counsel, the police has presented challan against the accused persons, after the completion of investigation. It will take time for completion of the trial, which is yet to commenced.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case the present petition is hereby accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
