ANIL KSHETARPAL, J (ORAL)

This order shall dispose of two appeals bearing FAO-462-2021 and FAO-560-2022.

In FAO-462-2021, an application under Section 151 CPC has been filed for placing on record a photocopy of the settlement deed arrived at between the parties. It has been stated that the original compromise deed has been filed before the Executing Court.

Since the original settlement deed is not a part of the file of the Court, it would not be appropriate to dispose of the appeals in terms of the settlement. In any case, as jointly prayed by learned counsel for the parties, both the appeals are disposed of with an observation that no further orders are

required to be passed in these appeals.

Learned counsel for the appellants in FAO-462-2021 has handed over 05 demand drafts amounting to Rs.10,40,000/- and Rs.2,60,000/- in cash to learned counsel for the respondents. Learned counsel for the respondents has acknowledged the receipt thereof. The statutory amount deposited while filing the appeals be remitted to the Executing Court.

The parties shall be at liberty to get their statements recorded before the Executing Court, where the original settlement deed has been filed.
