Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 for taking necessary action on the complaint/representation dated 24.02.2022 moved by him.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds that not only the petition lacks material particulars, but admittedly no complaint was ever made to the concerned SHO for alleged commission of offence. Apart from it, the petitioner can very well avail the alternative remedy in law.

Resultantly, no ground is made out for exercise of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
