Applicant/petitioner has filed the instant application seeking withdrawal of the main petition on the ground that Licence No.50 of 2022 dated 25.04.2022 issued by respondent No.3 to respondent No.7 has been suspended, consequently, no cause of action survives in the present writ petition.

In view of above, application is allowed and necessary permission to withdraw the main writ petition is granted.

Main Case

This civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for quashing and setting aside impugned order dated 03.11.2021 (Annexure P-10) and Licence No.50 of 2022 dated 25.04.2022 (Annexure P-13), issued by respondent No.3; and all other 'ancillary permissions' granted to respondent No.7 for the purpose of establishing a residential plotted colony under the Deen Dayal Jan Awas Yojna Scheme, 2016, in village Sarai Khwaja, Sector-43, Faridabad.

In view of the order passed in CM-19257-CWP-2022 of even date, present writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
