AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 598 dated 23.11.2019, under Section 379-A and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Barwala, District Hisar.

After arguing for some time and realising that the present petition is not maintainable in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in **Manish Jain v. Haryana State Pollution Control Board, 2021(1) AICLR 416**, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender before the court within fifteen days and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

Dismissed as not pressed. In case the petitioner surrenders within fifteen days and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within one day and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
