1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 25.02.2022, in CWP-2451-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-2451-2022, was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 herein to consider and decide representation dated 01.01.2022, filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondents have passed order Annexure R/1 dated 11.07.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 01.01.2022, therefore, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to challenge order dated 11.07.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as the statement

of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
