The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.332 dated 13.12.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the present is a case of a version and a cross version and FIR and DDR have been registered against both the parties. He further submitted that a fight had taken place due to a dispute of land between the parties and in fact it was the petitioner who also received injuries and that was the reason as to why the DDR was lodged against the other party. He has further submitted that it is yet to ascertain at the time of trial as to who was the aggressor party and the petitioner has clean antecedents and is not involved in any other case.

On the other hand, Mr. Amit Rana, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has stated, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, that it is correct that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court dated 11.05.2022, the petitioner has already joined investigation and he has fully cooperated with the investigation process and he has further instructions to say that the petitioner is not required for his custodial interrogations.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner, in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 11.05.2022, has already joined investigation and as per the learned State counsel, he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the aforesaid position, this Court deems it fit and proper to allow the present petition. Consequently, the present petition stands allowed and the order dated 11.05.2022 is hereby made absolute.
