This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner Nos. 1 and 3 have submitted a representation dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, but no action has been taken by the police, so far. He confines his prayer to the extent that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the said representation is decided by respondent No.2, within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 State only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to decide the representation dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.
