Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the respondents to look into the representation dated 05.04.2022, Annexure P-6 and to take action in accordance with law.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Head Quarter), Sirsa, has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record.

Upon instructions from L/ASI Manju, State counsel submits that representation, Annexure P-6, submitted by the petitioner has been enquired into and closed. She further submits that a report has been prepared and forwarded to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa.

In view of the statement made by State counsel, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition has become infructuous. He, however, seeks liberty to avail the remedy available to him.
