Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to conclude the investigation in a fair, impartial and in a time bound manner in case FIR No.127 dated 17.08.2019, FIR No.139 dated 26.08.2016, FIR No.140 dated 27.08.2019, FIR No.114 dated 31.07.2019 and FIR No.132 dated 21.08.2019, registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Sector 20, Panchkula, and further to take action against the accused persons.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, is on record and as per the reply, the private respondents, except Vinod Bagai who is suffering from acute Haemorrhagic stroke, were arrested and later on, they were released on bail.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from PSI Gurpal Singh, submits that challan has been presented and out of 23 PWs, only

02 PWs have been examined and the trial is proceeding.

Counsel appearing for respondent No.4 – Vinod Bagai, submits that even respondent No.4 was arrested and later on, was granted the concession of bail by the trial Court on medical grounds.

In view of the above, no further action is called for.
