The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 22.12.2021 (Annexure P-6), whereby the bail of the petitioner has been cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued in FIR No.233 dated 22.12.2019 registered under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC, 1860 and consequently charges have been framed under Sections 395, 482 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

On 30.05.2022, the following order was passed:-

“The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner appeared before the Trial Court on 25.11.2021 and the next date was inadvertently noted down as 22.12.2022 because of which the petitioner was not able to appear on the next date before the Trial Court i.e. on 22.12.2021. He further contends that the petitioner is still willing to appear before the Trial Court and join the proceedings.

Notice of motion for 05.09.2022.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court on the next date of hearing and shall be released on interim bail to its satisfaction.”

In terms of the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered and has since been admitted to interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
