1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/3 dated 07.02.2022, in CRM-M-4993-2022

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/3, reveals that CRM-M-4993-2022, was disposed of vide order dated 07.02.2022 by directing the respondent to look into the representation submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps as required in accordance with law at the earliest, preferably within four weeks from the date of order.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana states that pursuant to order dated 07.02.2022, a SIT was constituted on 11.02.2022. Learned State counsel further states that pursuant to the order constituting the SIT, report was submitted by the SIT and on the basis of the same, FIR against the accused has been cancelled on 18.04.2022. Copy of the order constituting the SIT as well as report submitted by the SIT besides, cancellation report submitted before the learned trial Court pursuant to

receipt of report is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to press the instant petition but liberty be granted to the petitioner to challenge cancellation report submitted by the SIT by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
