Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.46 dated 20.3.2021 registered under Sections, 307, 379-B, 341, 506, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

On 4.6.2021 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Petitioner prays for an anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.46, dated 20.03.2021, under Sections 307/379-B/341/506/323/148/149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that of the two injuries suffered by the complainant, as per the medico legal report one is simple in nature and injury No.2 is grievous i.e. fracture of nasal spine, but none is attributed to the petitioner. The only allegation against the petitioner is that he had caused kick blows. Nothing is to be recovered from him. And co-accused Gulab Kaur, Kamal Singh and Gursaran Singh have since been released on interim bail by this Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. H.S. Sullar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and prays for a short accommodation to file response/status report.

Adjourned to 27.09.2021.

To be heard with CRM-20102-2021 & CRM-M-21155-2021.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when required and shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined the investigation; has cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the order of this Court dated 4.6.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
