The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation of the case FIR No.11 dated 10.02.2019 registered at under Section 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhikhiwind District Amritsar to some senior police officer.

Notices served upon the official respondent(s) through the State's counsel-Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Sr. DAG, Punjab.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to make a representation to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran.

The prayer is innocuous and allowed.

Given above, in case the petitioner files any representation, the concerned Senior Superintendent of Police to decide the same within 15 days from the date of receipt of such representation by passing a speaking and reasoned order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

The petition is allowed to the extent mentioned above. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
