In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the family pension and gratuity were released to the petitioner after a delay, which was attributable to the respondents and the petitioner is entitled for grant of interest on the delayed release of the said benefits. The said prayer was rejected by the respondents vide order dated 17.02.2022 (Annexure P-7).

After notice of motion, the respondents have reconsidered the prayer of the petitioner and passed a fresh order dated 27.05.2022 granting the petitioner the benefit of interest on delayed release of family pension as well as of gratuity amount.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Mr. Amit Kumar, Executive Engineer, Punjab Water Supply and Sanitation Department, Malout, submits that the said order dated 27.05.2022 will be implemented within a period of 6 weeks from today and the interest so calculated will be released to the petitioner within the same time frame.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
