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In view of the oral agreed statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as learned counsel for the Insurance Company, both the parties have compromised for a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, to be paid to the appellant and respondent No.4 in equal share as full and final settlement of their claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two cheques/demand drafts in the sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs only) i.e. Rs.1,50,000/- in favour of appellant-Rupa Mahajan and another cheque/demand draft amounting to Rs.1,50,000/- in favour of respondent No.4-Punam, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today.

In case the amount is not deposited within the prescribed period, claimants shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum from the date of this order till the date of realization. The appellant's counsel may collect

the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. However, qua the cheque/draft of respondent No.4-Punam, Office is directed to intimate her about the order passed today and ask her to collect the cheque/draft and hand over the same to her on proper identification. The Office shall retain the photocopy of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the learned counsel for the appellant/claimant as a receipt on record.

Appeal stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be supplied to learned counsel for the parties.
