This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to consider the representation (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner and allow him to appear for physical screening test for the post of Male Constable (General Duty) against advertisement No.04/2020.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would contend that till date no action has been taken on the said representation and the petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Sanjay Mittal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 24.12.2021 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law, and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to pay costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
