Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate action on the representation dated 25.04.2022, Annexure P-4, submitted by the petitioner against respondents No.4 to 9.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was married to respondent No.4 on 10.04.2016 and gave birth to a son. However, she was turned out from the matrimonial home as the private respondents were making persistent demand of dowry. Counsel has submitted that after turning out the petitioner, respondent No.4 has married respondent No.9 without getting divorce from her and has an issue out of the said wedlock. Counsel submits that petitioner has submitted a representation dated 25.04.2022, Annexure P-4, to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur-respondent No.2, but no action is being taken thereon. He submits that petitioner would be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to examine the same.

Notice of motion, restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.A.Pathak, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on their behalf.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur-respondent No.2 to examine the representation, Annexure P-4, and take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.
