The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.11 dated 01.04.2022 registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 34 IPC, at Police Station Women, Patiala, District Patiala.

By virtue of the order dated 12.05.2022, the petitioner was directed to be released on interim bail on his appearance before the trial Court.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has joined the proceedings thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

However, learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is pending from the last one year and the petitioner is not appearing before the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that now the proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. are fixed before the learned trial Court for 19.12.2022 and he undertakes to appear before the concerned Court and join the proceedings on the date fixed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sanjiv Kumar, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 12.05.2022 is made absolute and petitioner is directed to keep appearing before the Court below as per the directions given by it.
