Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 01.04.2022, under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women Patiala, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 12.05.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 12.05.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute. He further submits that the mediation remained unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Gurjeet Kaur, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is

no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 12.05.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
