LISA GILL, J.

Petitioner has filed this writ petition for setting aside order 24.08.2018 whereby petitioner has been transferred from Government College for Women, Chhilro (Mohindergarh) to Government College, Rithoj (Gurugram) on 20.08.2018.

Notice of motion was issued in this writ petition on 08.05.2019, while noting contentions on behalf of the petitioner as under:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the judgment passed in CWP-16119-2016 Pardeep Singh and others V/s. State of Haryana and others (Annexure P-4), the State of Haryana made a policy dated 19.07.2018 and as per the sub clause (iii) of clause 5 of this policy, persons with 100% disabilities will be given their choice of posting and condition of five years stay will not be applicable to them.

 Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is 100% blind and he has been transferred at Govt.

College, Rithoj, Gurugram vide the impugned order dated 20.08.2018 (Annexure P-7), which is 30 kms away. He is seeking direction to the respondents to post him at Sector 14, Gurugram where he was posted for the last 29 years and he is on the verge of retirement as he has crossed the age of 58 years. He further states that on 31.05.2019, vacancy will be available in Government College for Women, Sector 14 Gurugram.”

Respondents were further directed to consider adjustment of the petitioner at Government College for Women, Sector 14, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the State while referring to Short reply dated 23.07.2019 filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2, submits that in compliance of order dated 08.05.2019, petitioner’s case was considered by the competent authority and petitioner was transferred as Principal (Current Duty Charge), Government College for Women, Sector 14, Gurugram from Government College, Rithoj (Gurugram). Petitioner joined on 07.06.2019, therefore, present writ petition, it is stated, is rendered infructuous.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. However, I do not find any justification to keep the matter pending any longer in view of the abovesaid facts which indicate that present writ petition is indeed rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

Liberty is, however, afforded to the petitioner to move an appropriate application within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in case any incorrect facts have been put forth before this Court.
