Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the claim of the petitioner has wrongly been rejected by the Chief Administrator of the respondent-Board vide impugned order dated 10.09.2021 (Annexure P/10). Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, it has been admitted in the impugned order that the petitioner is similarly situated as Uma Rani an another employee in whose favour the same benefit as being claimed by the petitioner, has been allowed by the respondent-Board after the said employee Uma Rani was held entitled to the said benefits by this Court while passing order in **CWP-15282 of 2013** tilted as **Uma Rani vs. State of Haryana and others** on 20.09.2016, therefore, not granting the said benefit to the petitioner by the respondents is discriminatory in nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the said impugned order, the petitioner has already filed an appeal (Annexure P/7),

which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction be issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the said appeal.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the appeal (Annexure P/7) preferred by the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in an appeal (Annexure P/7), respondent No.3 is directed to decide the appeal (Annexure P/7) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
