The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.162 dated 15.03.2020 registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Surender from the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 17.09.2021 as passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined in the investigation but he has been found to be innocent and his arrest is not required in the present case.

Keeping in view the above-discussed submission as

made by learned State counsel, it becomes quite explicit that the cause of action to pursue the present petition further, does not survive in favour of the petitioner any more.
