This petition is filed seeking quashing of order dated 2.5.2022 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran whereby non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner in FIR No. 33 dated 4.10.2016, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and Sections 13(1)(d) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Amritsar.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender before the trial court on the next date and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial court on the next date and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application on the same day and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
