Main case

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of code
of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case
FIR No.235 dated 4.9.2020 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468,
471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

As per allegations in the FIR, license to install CNG gas kits in
Tata 1512 TC was issued in the name of Jiolat Auto Gas Industries owned
by Suresh Chaudhary. However, said CNG gas kits were installed in Tata

1613 TC vehicles.

The petitioner was granted interim bail vide order dated 13.12.2021 and was directed to join investigation with the police.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Even counsel for the State on instructions from SI Sat Narayan submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any custodial interrogation by the police.

Admittedly, main accused/Suresh Chaudhary, proprietor of the concerned firm has already been granted concession of anticipatory bail by this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 13.12.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
