Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner retired on 31.03.2021 from service on attaining the age of superannuation but her pensionary benefits have not been released so far despite expiry of more than one year. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no impediment in release of the pensionary benefits and therefore, respondents be directed to release all the pensionary benefits forthwith along with interest.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anju Arora, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner has not made any representation with the respondents claiming the said benefit and in case,

petitioner makes any representation, the same will be decided within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the respondents by filing representation claiming the release of the pensionary benefits.

Ordered accordingly.
