Present petition is filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.4 dated 06.01.2017, under Sections 417 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, at the behest of respondent No.2, *inter alia* stating that the same is nothing but a sheer misuse of process of law.
