1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 17.05.2018, in CWP-7359-2018.
2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 17.05.2018, reveals that claim of the petitioner in CWP-7359-2018, for grant of interest on delayed payment of pension was allowed in view of judgment rendered in CWP-7386-2016, in case titled as Harmeet Kaur vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation decided on 23.04.2018.
3. Reply by way of affidavit dated 31.05.2022, has been filed on behalf of the respondent. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of interest having been paid to the petitioners in terms of the decision in Harmeet Kaur's case (supra), the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
