HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case, the challenge is to the order dated 28.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) by which, the petitioner has been suspended and her Head Quarter has been fixed at office of Block Education Officer, Pinjore, which is totally arbitrary and illegal for the reason that at the time of suspension, the petitioner was posted in Yamuna Nagar. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is a single lady and has a difficulty to approach the Head Quarter fixed in the impugned order and further no reason has been given as to why, the Head Quarter at Yamuna Nagar could not be fixed.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from Mr. Raj Kumar, Assistant submits that appropriate order changing the Head Quarter of the petitioner will be passed shifting the same from office of Block Education

Officer Pinjore to that of Office in Yamuna Nagar, when petitioner was posted at the time of passing the impugned order suspending her from service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this satisfy one of the grievance of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as enquiry is being held against the petitioner, however, petitioner is not being given due opportunity to defend herself as, certain relevant documents, which are in the possession of the respondents, are not being given to her though, a representation has been filed claiming the same.

Learned counsel for the respondents assures this Court that a free and fair enquiry will be held into the allegations being alleged against the petitioner and in case, the petitioner has any grievance, she can file a representation before the appropriate authority, in case she needs any documents or has any grievance qua the enquiry proceedings being conducted against her and appropriate order on the representation, if any filed, will be passed within a period of two weeks of the submission of the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this suffice the grievance of the petitioner and the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
