Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of order dated 23.11.2020 (Annexure P-1), whereby application moved by her under Section 239 Cr.P.C for discharge stands dismissed by Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala in case FIR No.39 dated 11.03.2019 registered under Sections 304-A IPC at Police Station Sadar Patiala.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the petitioner did not prefer any revision against the order dated 23.11.2020 and the trial has also commenced wherein prosecution has examined some of its witnesses and the petitioner has participated in the trial by cross-examining the prosecution witnesses.

Considering the above background as well as the stage of

the trial, this Court is not inclined to exercise inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C to interfere with the impugned order.
