Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.326 dated 08.12.2021 under Sections 323/324/341/34 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Lambi District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Vide order dated 13.05.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to above order, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is still required in the investigation.

Counsel for the petitioner states that his client would join the investigation as and when required by the police. In view of the above, interim order dated 13.05.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C and the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon by the investigating agency/investigating officer.

The present petition stands disposed off.
