Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, though the petitioner has retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.12.2018 but all the retiral benefits have not been released to him and that too without any valid justification. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even an increment for which the petitioner was entitled for on completion of his service has not been given to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance as raised by the petitioner in the present petition has already been raised in his representation dated 19.07.2021 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deepali Puri Sandhu, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 19.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the claim which has been raised by him in the representation dated 19.07.2021 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the same within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.
