Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is to set aside orders dated 4.2.2020 (Annexure P-6) and dated 24.8.2020 (Annexure P-10) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Panchkula in Civil Suit No. 86 of 2020 titled “Raj Rani vs. Gaurav Goyal and others”, vide which interim stay has been granted and the application for recalling of the said interim order has been dismissed. In the alternative, it is prayed that a direction may be issued to the Addl. Civil Judge (Senior Division), Panchkula, to decide/dispose off applications filed under Order 6 Rule 17 and Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure in time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 of the CPC was filed on 28.1.2020 and application under Order 6 Rule 17 of the CPC was filed on 1.7.2020. The trial court has not passed any orders in the above said applications till date.

He submits that he would be satisfied if the trial court is directed to decide

these applications in a time bound manner.

In view of limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the trial court is directed to decide the applications filed under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 and under Order 6 Rule 17 of the CPC in CS No. 86 of 2020 titled “ Raj Rani vs. Gaurav Goyal and others”, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from today.

Petition stands disposed of.
