Petitioners have approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.53 dated 06.03.2021 registered under Sections 323/341/506/34 IPC (Sections 325/308 IPC added later on) at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, who apprehend their arrest at the hands of Police.

On 10.06.2021 this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel contends that the FIR was initially registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 34 IPC and later on, the other offences under Sections 325 and 308 IPC were added. According to him, in the said occurrence, petitioner No.1 also suffered the injuries and on a complaint given by petitioner No.1, DDR No.54 dated 03.11.2020 was entered.

Notice of motion for 27.10.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioners associated themselves in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by ASI Des Raj, states that indeed the petitioner have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 10.06.2021 is made absolute.
