Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.305 dated 12.4.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station Chandani Bagh, Panipat, District Panipat.

FIR in this case was registered on the basis of the statement of complainant Naresh Kumar wherein he alleged that on 12.4.2022, the petitioner and his companions tres passed into his godown and also damaged his property.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation by virtue of order dated 13.5.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Status report by way of affidavit of Pardeep Kumar, DSP,

Crime Against Women, Panipat along with Annexure R-1 filed on behalf of respondent-State is ordered to be taken on record.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Rishi Pal has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation. He further submits that the challan against the petitioner is going to be filed very shortly in the Court concerned.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 13.5.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
