The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are major and are of marriageable age and they have got married with each other and they are facing threats from the respondents No.4 to 7 and in this regard, a representation dated 09.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) was given by the petitioners to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh but no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

Ms. Vasundhara Dalal Anand, learned APP for U.T. Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3. She has stated on instructions from ASI Rajesh that on the basis of advance copy of the present petition being received, the police officials had visited the residence of respondents No.4 to 7 and the aforesaid respondents No.4 to 7 have given their statements that they have neither posed any threat to the petitioners nor do they have any objection with regard to the marriage of the

petitioners and in future also they will not pose any threat to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned State counsel, he does not wish to press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
