Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in a cross case vide DDR No.28 dated 17.04.2022, registered for offences under Sections 323, 341, 354-B, 451, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short “IPC”), wherein Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (for short ‘SC&ST Act’) was added later on (Annexure P-2) in FIR No. 195 dated 17.04.2022, registered for offences under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, at Police Station Sohana, SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1).

Faced with the bar under Section 18-A (2) of the SC&ST Act, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail remedy available under the law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
