The petitioner's application for re-issuance of passport is not being proceeded with as a criminal trial is pending. The petitioner had approached the trial Court for grant of necessary relief but the trial Court has refused. Thus, the remedy available to the petitioner is to challenge the said order rather than filing a writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to challenge the order of the trial Court.
