[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/1 dated 07.03.2022 in CWP No.4423 of 2022 in case titled as Dr. Gurvinderjit Kaur Gill and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.4423 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent-authorities to decide legal notice dated 18.10.2021 filed by the petitioners in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of copy of the order and in case the petitioners were held entitled to the relief claimed and there was no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay.

[3] Learned counsel for respondent Nos.3 and 4 has produced copy

filed by the petitioners. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order, Annexure P/3 dated 25.04.2022 passed by respondent No.2 as well as order dated 16.07.2022 passed by respondent No. 4 rejecting the claim of the petitioners by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
