In civil suit No.96/2018 titled 'M/s Maharani Innovative Paints Pvt. Ltd. vs. M/s Durable Doors and Windows & another' for recovery of certain amounts, as is contended on behalf of the petitioner by Mr.Kunal Dawar, Advocate, the matter was listed for plaintiff's evidence and the petitioner had availed of nine opportunities to lead evidence but claims that on account of ill-health PW2 Pawan Malhotra could not appear for his cross-examination as a consequence of which the impugned orders (Annexure P2) were passed closing the evidence of the plaintiff.

Be that as it may, upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and ensuring that a party should not be denied right to legitimate opportunity of completing his evidence, it would be in the fitness of things if one opportunity is granted to the plaintiff to produce

their entire evidence as per the list of witnesses so filed, subject to payment of ₹ 10,000/- as costs, which shall be a pre-condition, to be paid to the opposite side for the delay that has been occasioned.

The revision petition stands disposed off accordingly.
