This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.287 dated 11.06.2020 registered under Sections 120B, 379, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Shahabad, Kururkshetra.

On 22.07.2020, a coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

CRM-17290-2020

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the Registry is directed to carry out the necessary corrections in head note of the petition as well as in the order dated 17.07.2020.

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Learned State Counsel and learned Counsel for the

complainant seek time to file reply.

Adjourned to 03.09.2020.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail by the arresting officer/investigating officer on furnishing of bail bonds by him to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigating officer. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. failing which he shall not be entitled to the protection of interim bail allowed to him.
