Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.10 dated 03.04.2022 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Women, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR (Annexure P-1) is fallout of a matrimonial dispute, which has been amicably settled before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court during pendency of the instant petition. He submits that in deference to the order passed by this Court on 19.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation.

This fact has been affirmed by the State counsel upon instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, who submits that petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Counsel for the complainant submits that she does not have any objection in case the interim order is made absolute.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Order dated 19.09.2022 is made absolute, subject to the fulfilment of conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
