This petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate action against respondents No.6 and 7.

Learned counsel for respondents No.6 and 7 has submitted that the FIR No.183 dated 22.11.2017, under Sections 376-D, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Haibowal, Ludhiana was registered against respondents No.6 and 7.

Learned State counsel, on the other hand, has submitted the status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Sameer Verma, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Ludhiana has already been filed. He has drawn the attention of this Court to the status report filed and has submitted that after registration of the FIR, the allegations of the complainant were thoroughly investigated and thereafter, all the allegations were found false. Accordingly, cancellation report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. had been prepared which was to be submitted before learned Magistrate.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the State that in case the cancellation report as submitted in the status report has not been filed before the concerned learned Magistrate then the same be filed within a month and the learned Magistrate would decide the same in accordance with law.

Petitioner is at liberty to pursue her remedies as available to her under law.
