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**VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)**

This is a Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has given a representation dated 27.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, in which, he has detailed incidents so as to show that reasonable apprehension has been caused in his mind with regard to his life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as far as prayer in the said representation for registration of case against the

private respondents is concerned, neither he wishes to press the said prayer nor he presses the prayer for taking of possession of the premises, which is in the occupation of the private respondents and thus, only prays for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied in case, the present Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, to look into the representation dated 27.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) only with respect to protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On advance notice, Mr. Sarabjit S. Cheema, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and on a specific query put by this Court, he has stated that he has no objection in case, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, looks into the representation dated 27.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) with a limited prayer for only protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and takes appropriate action in accordance with law.

After considering the facts and circumstances of the present case, this Court deems it appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, to look into the representation dated 27.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) with a limited prayer for only protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and after making necessary enquiries and assessing the threat perception to the petitioner, respondent No.2 shall

take appropriate action in accordance with law.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not gone into the merits of the allegations made by the petitioner and it would be open to respondent No.2 to make his independent enquiry/assessment with regard to the representation with a limited prayer aforesaid.

In view of what has been observed above, the present Criminal Writ petition is disposed of in the abovesaid terms.

It is, however, clarified that this order shall not debar the State from proceeding against the petitioner, if involved in any case.
